





MISSION

The Causeless Happiness Organisation works to improve quality of life through community-based initiatives, focusing on sustainable resource management and social well-being. A key part of their work is distributing free medicine to children and the poor in villages, a service they are committed to continuing.

VISION

The organization provides comprehensive support to underprivileged, slum, and street children, offering free education, nutritious food, and medication. They also extend this assistance to remote villages and victims of calamities, supplying financial aid, food, clothing, and other essential needs. The organization also operates its own free rehabilitation center for mentally and physically challenged children.



KEY HIGHLIGHTS OF 2022

1. Health and Wellness

Provided financial and medical support to children with cancer.

Organised medical camps and distributed free medicines in villages and slums.

Expanded food distribution programs to provide nutritious meals to thousands.

2. Educational Empowerment

Offered free education and learning materials to children from slum communities.

Distributed thousands of stationery kits to school children.

Gave financial, emotional, and guidance support to orphaned children.

3. Community and Social Development

Participated in the "Clean India" campaign to promote hygiene and health.

Supported a wheelchair cricket team to empower differently-abled individuals.

Provided emergency relief, including food and clothing, during hardships.

KEY INITIATIVES

- **Financial Assistance and Medical Support:** We provide direct financial aid to cover the exorbitant costs of cancer treatment, including chemotherapy, radiation, and surgeries. Our support extends to purchasing crucial medications, diagnostic tests, and medical supplies that are often out of reach for low-income families.

- **Nutritional and Food Aid:** Recognizing that proper nutrition is vital for a patient's recovery and overall well-being, we distribute free, high-protein nutritional kits to cancer patients and their families. This initiative ensures that those weakened by illness and poverty have access to the essential sustenance needed to endure treatment.

- **Holistic Care and Rehabilitation Centers:** We operate rehabilitation centers that offer a "home away from home" for out-of-town patients and their caregivers. These centers provide a safe, clean, and supportive environment, along with counseling services and recreational activities to address the psychological and emotional challenges faced by patients and their families. Our goal is to create a community of support that empowers patients to regain their health and dignity.

CHALLENGES

Financial instability is a major challenge for our organization, as we rely on inconsistent donations and grants. Logistical issues, like poor roads in remote areas, delay the delivery of crucial aid. We also face community resistance due to distrust or traditional beliefs, and our limited number of staff and volunteers can lead to burnout. Finally, it's difficult to measure and report the long-term impact of our work, adding to administrative burdens and the constant need for transparency.





GOALS

- Empowering Children Through Education: Provide access to quality education, including school supplies, uniforms, and scholarships, to break the cycle of poverty.
- Nourishing Communities: Fight hunger by distributing food, operating community kitchens, and ensuring consistent access to nutritious meals for families and children.
- Providing Healthcare and Well-being: Offer essential healthcare services through medical camps, free consultations, and assistance with medicines.
- Creating a Sustainable Future: Empower people to become self-reliant by providing vocational training and micro-enterprise support.

EDUCATION SUPPORT.




The Causeless Happiness Organisation provides crucial education support for underprivileged children, aiming to give them the opportunity to learn and break the cycle of poverty. A significant part of this initiative involves their distribution of School Kits. These kits, sometimes referred to as "Happiness Study Kits," are essential for a child's educational journey, typically containing basic but vital supplies such as notebooks, pens, pencils, rulers, erasers, and often a backpack. By supplying these school kits, the organization directly alleviates the financial burden on poor families and ensures that children have the necessary tools to attend school with dignity and confidence, thereby encouraging enrollment and reducing dropout rates. The organisation also states that it provides free education to slum, poor, and street children, often combining this with support for health and nutritious food.

SUPPORT FOR CANCER PATIENTS.



Causeless Happiness Organisation provides medical support to individuals suffering from various diseases, with a specific focus on cancer patients, particularly children. The organization aims to improve the quality of life for those in need by offering financial assistance for medical treatments, including chemotherapy and surgery. 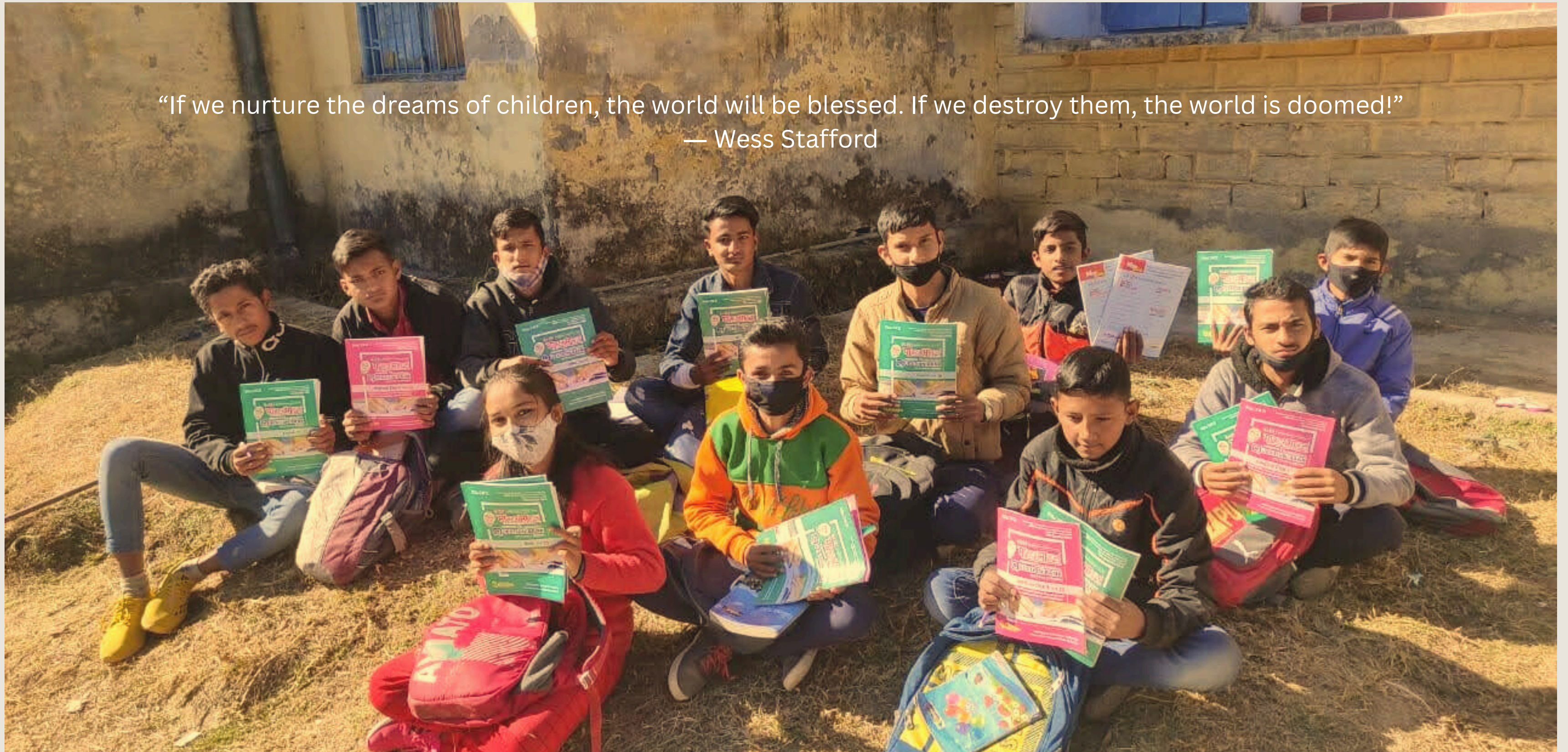
